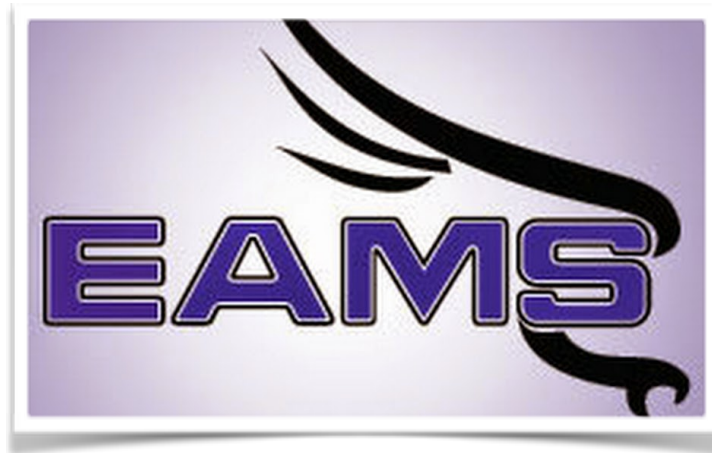


# Falcon Updates

Our grade 7 students are looking forward to the opportunity to visit Blackfoot

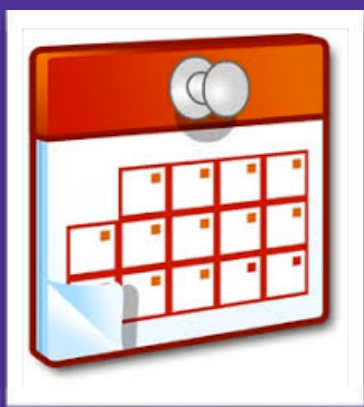
